Second letter from IRS (Cincinnati Office, OH) on July 24, 2001 The case was transferred to National Office, Washington D.C. for ruling. My call - July 26, 2001 - Not assigned to an officer. My call - August 15, 2001 - Not Assigned to an officer. My call - September 14, 2001 - Assigned to Lee Phaup 202-283-8935.
 What will be helpful to get a favorable judgment? Or to accelerate granting (in other words, to shorten the pending period)? (1) Funding promise from Foundations. (By phone talk with IRS) (2) Sympathetic letters from other nonprofit organizations or people. (My idea) (3) Do self-study of IRS's nonprofit laws by Internet, and legally approach to IRS. (My idea, www.nolo.com)

(4) USC Doheny Memorial Library, nonprofit (I recently received an invitation for Grand Reopening of the Library). (5) American Lutheran Church, nonprofit (I am an active member). (6) Abram Friedman Occupational Center's teacher (LAUSD, I am an active student there). (7) KCET-TV, nonprofit (I have a partnership through LAJCC about Ready to Learn community outreach).

- (8) Shakespeare By The Sea, nonprofit (I briefly introduced our corporation to a key person, Lisa Coffi).
- (9) Los Angeles Public Library (I just applied to work as a volunteer at Library Foundation of Los Angeles, nonprofit).
- (10) Grand Performances, nonprofit (Los Angeles downtown, Celebrate the world, Celebrate L.A.!) (I just watched one performance).
- (11) Mark Taper Forum at Music Center, nonprofit (Performing art, I was there).
- (12) Museum of Television & Radio (Beverly Hills, CA) (I received two letters but have not answered yet).
- (13) Thousand Oaks Library American Radio Archives (I visited there once).
- (14) A couple of museums: LACMA (I visited there at 'Made in California' now for kids), MoLLA(Museum of Latin American Art), UCLA Hammar Museum.
